Dear Mr. Duran:

On July 16, 2019 the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division) conducted an inspection of the above referenced site. Compliance with Mine Plan was cited as a problem for excessive stockpiling of imported materials. Corrective actions required you to provide the Division with an estimate of the imported materials volume so that it could be bonded for by the corrective action date. On October 8, 2019, the Division received the required corrective action documentation. This satisfies the corrective action and it is considered abated.

Since this inspection, TR-2 has allowed for the crushing of imported materials so that they can be sold and no longer bonded for. Crushing should be completed in 2019, the Division will conduct a follow up site inspection in 2020 to verify and evaluate the need for bonding of imported materials.
