- 1. As discussed in the report form, no activity has begun at the site.
- 2. The reason for delay was the time required to have the operation approved by La Plata County.
- 3. The County approval is dependent on changing the alignment of the access road to accommodate the requirements of adjacent landowners and other concerned persons.
- 4. The realignment will require requesting and obtaining the Division's approval of a technical revision or an amendment to the permit to reflect the changes required by the County.
- 5. The permitting engineer is presently working on this request to submit to the Division, but there is no clear schedule as of yet for this submission.
- 6. The map submitted for the 2017 and 2018 reports was an incorrect and incomplete map.
- 7. Although there has been no activity and therefore no affected land on the permit area, a different, correct map from the 2015 application exhibits is part of this annual report. This correctly shows the permit and proposed affected area and the original planned road alignment.
- 8. Deb Koenig, the previous contact for Crossfire Aggregate Services, LLC, is no longer with CAS, and we are in the process of updating the contact information with all agencies.
