Hello Mr. Ebert – Thank you for extending this deadline until November 25, 2019. We appreciate that, greatly.

We will need to continue to review the applicable regulations and the current permit for any seasonality aspects and/or conditions that may affect our compliance, in this regard. The site is located above 10,200 feet AMSL and is greatly impacted by the onset of winter conditions. We are discussing increasing activity of the site in the near term (Q1/Q2, 2020), potentially obviating the need for a continuance of temporary cessation. This, among other factors, will force us to be cautious in our planning for compliance with this corrective action.
