Dear Mr. Dangler:

The Colorado Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety (Division), has been made aware through various communications with local jurisdictions that you may no longer be in compliance with other applicable Federal, State and Local permits that are required. To date the Division has not received any formal letters of non-compliance from these jurisdictions. However, as a reminder pursuant to C.R.S. 34-32.5-109 (3), you are required to comply with city, town, county land use regulations.

It is the Division understands that there may be issues with RMR's Garfield County Special Use Permit. Please advise the Division as to how you are working to resolve these potential non-compliance issues.

RMR is reminded of the commitments they made to the Division on February 22, 2017 (see attached). This commitment includes resolving BLM compliance issues as well as reporting to the Division progress being made towards that effect. Please send written quarterly updates no later than December 31, March 31, June 30, and September 30 for the previous quarter.

Dear Ms. Yeldell,

As requested in the letter dated January 17, 2017 from the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division), RMR Aggregates, Inc. (RMR) is committed to the following:

- The active operation will not make any further disturbances in the area identified as being out of the approved permit boundaries.
- RMR will provide the Division with copies of all material submitted to the BLM
- Upon submittal of the BLM Plan of Operations (POO) modification RMR shall provide the division with a progress update quarterly until the matter is resolved.
- Within 60 days of the BLM POO modification approval RMR will submit an amendment to the Division.
 - The amendment at a minimum will incorporate all affected lands within the permit boundary.
 - o The amendment will modify all exhibits to meet the standards of the current Rules.
- RMR agrees that if any of these stipulations are violated the Division may set this matter for a hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board.
