Re: REPEAL OF "1041" REGULATIONS FOR SAGE-GROUSE HABITAT

Dear Mr. Plumhoff:

This letter is to confirm that Montrose County has repealed the "1041" regulations regarding the protection of the Sage-grouse habitat. Recently, the United States Fish and Wildlife Service ("FSW") listed the bird as endangered under the Endangered Species Act, 15 U.S.C. 1531, et seq. ("the ESA") making the County regulations of the Sage-grouse redundant and superseded by the FSW's Final Rules.

As the County is no longer regulating the Sage-grouse habitat, there is no longer an obligation for your client, Lazy K, to comply with the County's permit requirements or any of the repealed regulations. Further, the \$25,000.00 held in escrow with Black Canyon Regional Land Trust, which was to pay the transaction costs to facilitate the conveyance of a permanent conservation easement, is no longer needed. The County does not require Lazy K to obtain a Special Permit and therefore, the money should be returned to your client.
