OBSERVATIONS

The Henderson Mill facility was inspected by the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) as part of the Division's monitoring inspection program. The following Division staff members were present for the inspection; Peter Hays, Amy Eschberger and Zach Trujillo. The purpose of the inspection was to familiarize the DRMS staff with the Henderson Mill facilities. Mr. Aaron Hilshorst with Climax Molybdenum - Henderson Operations (Henderson) was present during the inspection and conducted the Mill tour.

The inspection began with a meeting to discuss the on-going and pending permitting items at the site. The following topics were discussed: the amendment application (AM-07), the pending revised Henderson Closure Cost Model, the pending revised Environmental Protection Plan and the as-built drawings for the 3-Dam buttress project (TR-29), 1-Dam Seep Water Collection System Improvements (TR-30), 3-Dam Seepwater Return Line Clean-Out Ports (TR-31).

The following Mill facilities were observed and/or discussed during the tour; ore storage building, NOKES building, mill building, milling process, west portal, PC2/PC3 transfer station, PC2 and PC3 alignments, tailings storage impoundment, ultimate canal, Ute Park pump house, groundwater extraction and monitoring wells, East Branch pump house, Tailing Delivery Line (TDL) and barge pump house.

The mill was operational and tailings were being deposited on 3-Dam during the inspection. No photographs were taken during the inspection.
