Mr. Johnson,

On December 9, 2019, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) conducted an inspection of the proposed construction materials site, Skull Creek, Permit No M2019-054. The current decision date for the permit application is February 23, 2020. Upon the inspection it was made aware that the "Old Mine Road" will be significantly improved. Pursuant with Rule 1.1(3), affected lands include but shall not be limited to private ways, roads, except those roads which existed prior to the date on which notice was given or the permit application was made to the office and which were constructed for purposes unrelated to the proposed mining operation and which will not be substantially upgraded to support the mining operation. New and improved roads must be included as part of the permitted acreage. Please revise the Exhibit A - Legal Description and all application amendment exhibits to include the acreage for all proposed affected lands. Affected lands must encompass and be within the permit boundaries.

The Division will require the Applicant to submit an application amendment pursuant to Rule 1.8.1. If the Applicant fails to submit the application amendment or waiver by the decision date, the Division will deny the application and terminate the application file. Application Amendments require re-noticing procedures in pursuant to Rule 1.8.1.
