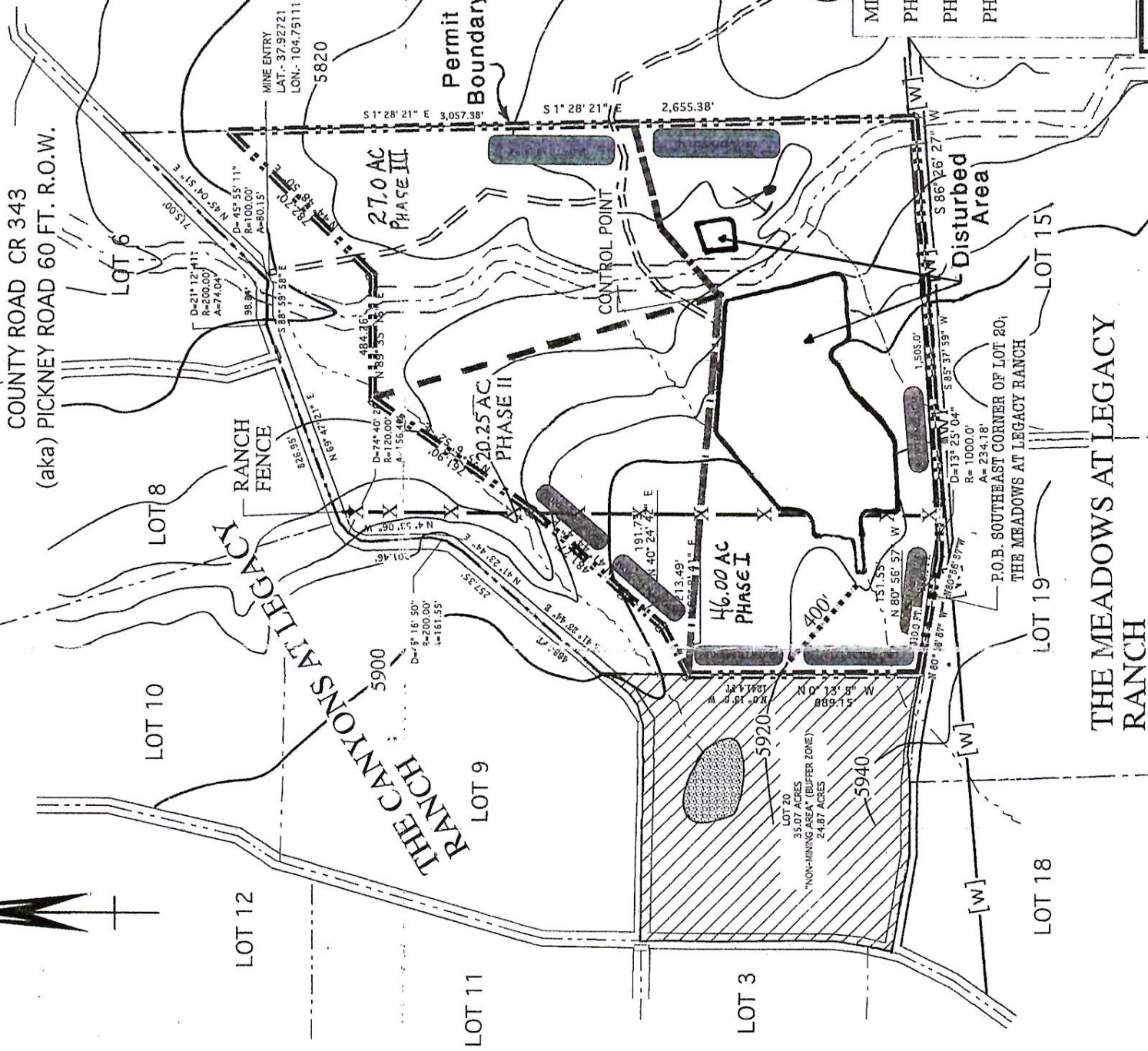

PERMIT LEGAL CEDARWOOD CLAY MINE

A PARCEL OF LAND LOCATED IN A PORTION OF SECTION 27 AND 34, TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 66 WEST OF THE 6TH P.M., BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF LOT 20, THE MEADOWS AT LEGACY RANCH, ACCORDING TO THE RECORDED PLAT THEREOF;

Thence N 80° 56' 57" W, a distance of 310.00 feet, Thence N 00° 13' 05" W, a distance of 889.15 feet, Thence N 62° 08' 41" E, a distance of 213.49 feet, Thence N 40° 24' 42" E, a distance of 191.73 feet, Thence N 41° 44' 04" E, a distance of 481.77 feet, Thence N 35° 06' 52" E, a distance of 761.90 feet, Thence N 89° 35' 16" E, a distance of 484.26 feet, Thence N 44° 48' 50" E, a distance of 782.70 feet, Thence S 01° 28' 21" E, a distance of 2655.38 feet, Thence S 85° 37' 59" W, a distance of 1505.00 feet, Thence on the arc of a curve to the right, through a central angle of 13° 25' 04", whose radius is 1000.0 feet, an arc length of 234.18 feet, Thence N 80° 56' 57" W, a distance of 151.55 feet, to the POINT of Beginning, containing 93.25 acres, more or less.
