On December 16, 2019, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received via email from Paul Kos (Stantec) a request to extend the decision date for Amendment No. 4 (AM-04) by 30 days. The original decision date was December 19, 2019. The DRMS accepts this request as a waiver to the 90-day review period for amendments pursuant to Rule 1.4.13.

The DRMS noted the extension request included language stating "Castle Aggregate does not waive the automatic approval provision provided in Construction Materials Rule 1.4.13(1)." Pursuant to Rule 1.4.13(2): "Where an Applicant has waived its right, in writing, to a decision by the deadlines set forth in statute or by these Rules, the automatic approval provisions of Rule 1.4.13(1) shall not apply."
