### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted by Brock Bowles of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division). Robert Christian (Operator) were present for the inspection. The Elbert County Pit is located about 1 mile north of Elbert, Colorado. The site is an active 112c operation with 38.7 acres permitted. This inspection was carried out at the request of Mr. Christian to discuss the phased reclamation boundaries. At the time of the inspection it was cool and clear. The ground was frozen and becoming muddy as the temperature rose.

Christian Construction submitted AM2 on February 20, 2019 to add 39.23 acres to the permit. During the AM2 review process, it was noted that the current disturbance was within reclamation Phase A and Phase C. This inspection was conducted to ground-truth the reclamation phase boundaries, verify the location of the current disturbance in relation to the reclamation phase boundaries and to discuss options for managing the cost of the reclamation bond.

The permit entrance sign was in place.
