COMMENTS

This was a complete inspection of the Southfield Mine conducted by Zach Trujillo of Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) on December 23, 2019. The Southfield Mine was an underground mine which the Division has revoked the bond and terminated the permit. Therefore, no mine operator remains. All bond monies available to the Division will be utilized as needed for reclamation and maintenance activities. The weather was cloudy and ground conditions were snowcovered. Temperatures during the inspection were around forty five degrees fahrenheit.

On November 13, 2018, a meeting was held between the Division and The Corley Company. During this meeting, Dr. Corely, president of The Corley Company, informed the Division that it was best that the Division no longer access the site on the lands owned by The Corely Company. Based upon that meeting, the Divisoin no longer inspects that portion of the Southfield Mine.

RECLAMATION SUCCESS - Rule 4.15, Rule 3:

The Road Spur remains stable with good vegetation. Vegetation can be seen established through the snow cover. The two track was snow covered but noticeable vegetation was observed.

The reclaimed substation pad was snow covered but vegetation was visible. Tracks from an ATV or other small vehicle was observed at the reclaimed access road to the pad. It appears that this area is being used to access adjacent land.
