On January 30, 2020 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety **approved** the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on January 6, 2020, addressing the following:

- *Request for Permit Boundary Markers offset including additional markers; verify the completion of Corrective Actions regarding the burn pit located on site; Incorporate the use of an above ground fuel storage tank in the Middle Mine Area.*

The terms of the Technical Revision No. 3 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1996-076. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1996-076 remain in full force and effect. The approval of this Technical Revision also resolves the remaining corrective actions regarding the Noxious Weed Management Plan and the updating of the Mine Plan to incorporate the use of the Above Ground Fuel Storage Tank cited in the Inspection Report dated September 18, 2019. It also resolves the Corrective Actions regarding the Permit Boundary Markers cited in the Inspection Report dated July 12, 2019. All Inspection problems are hereby considered resolved.
