On 3 October 2019, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety completed a findings document for the Midterm Permit Review (MT-05) for the Bowie No. 2 Mine, and in conjunction with this midterm review, we updated the Reclamation Cost Estimate (RCE) for this mine. The adjusted RCE increased the required surety by \$40,169.45.

This letter, in accordance with Rule 3.02.2(4)(a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Coal Mining, is to inform you that you have the opportunity to request an informal conference on this adjustment.
