



Areas regraded and vegetated by Boulder County Parks and Open Space (BCPOS) with Grant Money as part of the St. Vrain Restoration Project 2018-2019 (5.5 ac)

- 1 Plant Site – 5 acres
Board of Adjustments and Boulder County District Court upheld County Land Use Dept's decision. Save Our St Vrain has appealed to the Appellate Court. Waiting to prepare site to begin mining again (septic, building permits, etc) until judges decision, anticipated in 2020.
- 2 Sediment deposited by St. Vrain Creek from Breach 1 from the 2013 flood - 8.99 acres*
- 3 Sediment deposited by St. Vrain Creek from Breach 2 from the 2013 flood - 10.5 acres*
- 4 Sediment deposited by St. Vrain Creek from Breach 2. Boulder County Parks and Open Space working with FEMA, Corps of Engineers and SEO to re-establish water storage reservoir and remove sediment – 9.99 acres

*MM intends to re-mine to re-establish prior reclamation, Boulder County would like for it to remain as-is. Discussions will continue.
