
Greetings,

There has been no new mining activity. Stockpile sales of processed material have currently depleted the  $\frac{3}{4}$ " minus and approximately half of the 1" minus and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " minus materials located east and north east of the scale platform within the stockpile area. Once all stockpiles are removed mining can extract a large deposit in the previous mined area located east of the scale to the lower level pond and north to the silt pond areas.

Area spraying of weeds occurred on June 8<sup>th</sup>. Plants are fewer in number and rather stunted due to drought conditions. They are more prevalent along the southern border and along the irrigation system both windblown and water source as possible transfer from neighboring properties.
