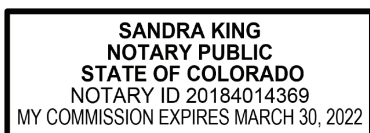

Cripple Creek & Victor Gold Mining Company, 100 North 3rd Street (P.O. Box 194) Victor, CO 80860, (719) 689-4156, has filed an application to amend its Regular (112d) Designated Mining Operations Reclamation Permit with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board under the provisions of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act. The mine project is known as the Cresson Project, and is currently operating under the above-referenced permit type. The Cresson Project is in the Cripple Creek Mining District and centered in Section 30 Township 15 South, Range 68 West, 6th Principal Meridian.

The proposed amendment will commence as soon as necessary permits are obtained, which is anticipated to be January 2021. The proposed date of completion for reclamation activities for the affected land is 2042. The proposed future use of the affected land is livestock grazing and wildlife habitat.
