On March 2, 2020, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your request to extend the expiration date for the first term of Temporary Cessation (TC-1) for the Potts Pit #2 from May 2020 to May 2021 because of activity that the pit for a period of four months in 2019. **The Division herby approves the extension request to May 2021.** The Operator should be aware that when TC-1 expires they will be required to either resume mining operations, enter into final reclamation (5 year period) or request a second term of TC which will require a hearing before the Board for final approval.
