**Subject: Request for extension of Temporary Cessation period  
Potts Pit #2 – Permit M2006-013**

Dear Mr. Lennberg:

Eastern Colorado Aggregates, LLLP (ECA), has a five-year Temporary Cessation (TC1) for the Potts Pit #2, which expires May 2020. ECA is notifying the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) that the Potts Pit #2 was active during 2019 and requests to save one year of TC1 so the TC1 expires in May 2021.

ECA temporarily activated Potts Pit #2 from June 2019 until September 2019 while reject material was hauled off the Potts Pit #2 site to a nearby project. No new mining activity took place. ECA was unaware of the need to notify the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) that the pit was being activated during a five-year Temporary Cessation. ECA is now providing that notice. The pit has gone back into TC1. Currently, ECA is undecided about the future plans for the pit.
