Subject: Release of Reclamation Acreage AR-04

Dear Ms. Eschberger,

With the recent objection to the Release of Reclamation AR-04 based on the water ponds just north of the proposed Permit line change, I have reviewed and have modified the request as per attached map. Holcim has modified the acreage to reflect that all areas showing water impoundment are excluded from the acreage being released.

In reference to the above stated permit, Holcim (US) is now formally requesting a partial release of acreage for the Boettcher Limestone Quarry. Acreage was determined by the 2005 map showing the Amended Permit Boundary which included the 377 acres released in 2005. The difference between the Amended Permit Acreage and the actual acreage is +/- 862 Acres. In determining the Northern parcel, which Holcim is requesting release, the acreage within the Amended Permit Boundary in the North Parcel is +/-702 acres of which 377 was released in 2005, thus the actual release requested is +/-325 acres The +/- 325 acres which Holcim (US) Inc. has complied with all applicable portions of the reclamation Plan requirements and is considering reclamation to be complete. The acreage consists of the Northern most parcel within the reclamation permit; the affected land is wholly owned by:

The area south of parcel will remain within the permit limits and consists of a parcel that includes the water ponds and the CKD Disposal sites – which is estimated to be **+/- 537 Acres**.


