OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the review process for the 112c conversion application (CN-1) that was submitted to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) on October 4, 2019. Pursuant to Rule 3.2 (7), 110c operations applying for 112c conversion shall be inspected after the application is filed and prior to Board consideration. On the date of this attempted inspection significant snow amount still covered the access road, preventing access to the site. Therefore, the inspector was unable to reach the site in order to conduct the required inspection. Another attempt to inspect the site will be made once the snow has cleared enough to allow access to the site.
