Dear Ms. Eschberger,

Aggregate Industries-WCR Inc. ("Aggregate Industries") has requested to postpone completion of reclamation operations at our Lyons Quarry (M1977-141) until Spring of 2022, a delay of one year. In a letter received on April 8, 2020, the DRMS indicated that the postponement request was acceptable, however that in order to be approved, Aggregate Industries must submit a detailed reclamation schedule. We have developed the attached reclamation schedule based on the original reclamation scope of work (SOW) that was approved by the DMRS in 2019. This SOW was designed, bid, and awarded in 2019 with construction anticipated to begin in Spring 2020.

As presented in the schedule, we anticipate completing reclamation in the spring of 2022, however given the uncertainties regarding this COVID-19 Pandemic, this schedule is a best estimate based on information available at this time. Our proposed schedule assumes that delays from the COVID-19 pandemic will not extend beyond late Summer 2020 and that there is no change in the reclamation SOW or requirements.

We are committed to meeting our reclamation obligations onsite, and appreciate your consideration of Aggregate Industries extension request at the proposed schedule.
