Greetings:

The Nyholt (aka Mann) Pit was mined for several years by Mobile Pre-Mix / Lafarge. Lafarge ceased mining operations in December of 2009. Adams County Parks accepted succession of operator in December of 2009 and will continue to remove stockpiled material, control noxious weeds at the site, establish native grasses and complete required site reclamation.

In 2017 and 2018, Adams County parks and Open Space submitted a partial release request and release of 66.63 acres leaving a total of 242.07 acres within the permit boundary (see attached map).

In 2018, Adams County and their water storage partners began a major water conveyance project interconnect pipelines and also started work on inlet and outlet structures necessary to bring the water storage vessels on-line and make them fully operational. Todd Creek Village Metropolitan District is completing the work through an IGA with Adams County and South Adams County Water and Sanitation District. Todd Creek's selected contractor was to complete any testing and certification required through the State Engineer's Office. Unfortunately, due to project challenges and an ultimate settlement with the General Contractor these improvements and subsequent liner certifications were delayed in 2019. However, the project is back on track and expected to be completed sometime in 2020. We would like to thank you in advance for your assistance and patience regarding this delay.

Enclosed is a site map illustrating site work, weed mitigation and other work that was completed in the 2019 calendar year and work anticipated in 2020.
