Mr. Hughes,

Thank you for your interest and alerting us to the activity you observed at the Snyder Quarry. The Snyder Quarry has an active permit with the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (file no. M-1977-210). All of the activity you described is allowed under the approved permit. I contacted the Operator and they acknowledged the activity was taking place today and they expect to complete the removal of currently stockpiled material by the end of this week. The Operator expects to have more truck activity sometime in May as they remove some onsite equipment. So, you may observe additional truck activity next month as well.

Hello Camille, Ginny, Lauren, and Tim,

I have noticed this morning and continuing into this afternoon that there is an <u>EXTREME</u> amount of trucks carrying aggregate out of the Snyder Quarry (Castle Concrete) on Black Canyon Rd. in Colorado Springs. This quarry is technically <u>abandoned</u>, but it's absolutely amazing how many trucks are driving out of this property right now. In 19 minutes I videoed 12 loaded trucks departing the quarry. The trucks were not apparently owned by Castle Concrete, as all were identified with <u>different</u> company names like ZDS Enterprises, Selke, Hazelton, McCarthy, Stuck, Altitude, All Purpose, etc., etc. <u>I suspect something illegal is going on, either orchestrated by Castle – or that Castle itself is</u> **Currently** be robbed.

I will not contact Castle as they may be the perpetrators, not the victims. Please investigate this immediately, and also please advise me if my videos are of value.
