Ponds appear to be holding water but not discharging. Little dry creek is flowing and does not appear to be flooding. No erosional features were noted from the aerial photos.





Parking lot appears to be growing over in weeds. Rail across Hwy 40 is currently still present. It appears ballast has been removed from the North side of Hwy 40 and reclamation working is occurring.
