The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has completed the initial review of materials submitted by Mountain Coal Company, LLC (MCC) in support of the MR-444 application. The Division's comments and questions are below, with items that need to be addressed highlighted in bold type.

Rule 2.10.3(2) – Maps and Plans

1. The rule requires that "Maps, plans, and cross-sections... shall be prepared by or under the direction of, and certified by, a qualified registered professional engineer or professional geologist..."

Please update the map titled "MR-444 - REVISED MVB ROAD AND PAD LOCATIONS FOR LW E14 PANEL" with an electronic PE or PG certification.

The proposed decision due date for MR-444 is May 28, 2020.
