Mr. Lennberg,

Please see the number responses below that correspond with the Adequacy Review.

- 1. The correct pages of the permit application are resubmitted and attached.
- 2. All maps meet the minimum requirements referenced.
- 3. All maps are signed and dated.
- 4. A table has been added to provide coordinates for each permit boundary corner.
- 5. There will be a highway as indicated on the mining map. Whenever it is feasible, the highwall will be pushed down in the manner discussed in the narrative to shorten the length of such highwall and to keep it at a minimum.
- 6. Soil will be replaced at 4-6 inches and the operator commits to such across the disturbed areas.
- 7. Fremont Paving and Redi Mix commits to following CPW's recommendation as listed in their letter and again in this adequacy review.
- 8. Through 12. All requested map updates have been made.
- 13. The well indicated in the adequacy review belongs to the landowner. An updated structure agreement is attached.
- 14. This response has been submitted to the Huerfano County Clerk and Recorder. Attached is proof of mailing for verification.

Structure Agreement

This letter has been provided to you as the owner of a structure on or within two hundred (200) feet of a proposed mine site. The State of Colorado, Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety ("Division") requires that where a mining operation will adversely affect the stability of any significant, valuable and permanent man-made structure located within two hundred (200) feet of the affected land, the Applicant shall either:

- a) Provide a notarized agreement between the Applicant and the Person(s) having an interest in the structure, that the Applicant is to provide compensation for any damage to the structure; or
- b) Where such an agreement cannot be reached, the Applicant shall provide an appropriate engineering evaluation that demonstrates that such structure shall not be damaged by activities occurring at the mining operation; or
- c) Where such structure is a utility, the Applicant may supply a notarized letter, on utility letterhead, from the owner(s) of the utility that the mining and reclamation activities, as proposed, will have "no negative effect" on their utility. (*Construction Materials Rule 6.3.12 and Rule 6.4.19 & Hard Rock/Metal Mining Rule 6.3.12 and Rule 6.4.20*)

The Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board ("Board") has determined that this form, if properly executed, represents an agreement that complies with Construction Materials Rule 6.3.12(a), Rule 6.4.19(a), and C.R.S. § 34-32.5-115(4)(e) and with Hard Rock/Metal Mining Rule 6.3.12(a), Rule 6.4.20(a), and C.R.S. § 34-32-115(4)(d). This form is for the sole purpose of ensuring compliance with the Rules and Regulations and shall not make the Board or Division a necessary party to any private civil lawsuit to enforce the terms of the agreement or create any enforcement obligations in the Board or the Division.
