22% Mountain Brome, Bromus marginatus

22% Canada Wildrye, Elymus canadensis

16% Little Bluestem, Schizachyrium scoparium

14% Blue Grama, Bouteloua gracilis

14% Arizona Fescue, Festuca arizonica

12% Slender Wheatgrass, Elymus trachycaulus
