Per our conversation on 6/18/2020, this letter serves to inform your department that Kiewit Infrastructure Co. will be storing large equipment such as 777D off-highway trucks at our Fountain Colony Pit. As this is an inactive and unstaffed facility that does **not** maintain a condition of no exposure, the storing of equipment will not effect our current inspection frequency or permit requirements.

Good housekeeping practices will be implemented to maintain a clean and orderly environment; the individual and/or crew driving on site will make sure all equipment is working properly and that preventative maintenance on the equipment is kept up. Routine inspections of the equipment for leaks or conditions that could result in a leak will be implemented and all leaks, drips, or spills will be cleaned up immediately.
