In accordance with Rule 2.02.6(3)(a) of the Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Coal Mining, adopted in accordance with the Colorado Surface Mining Act, C. R. S. 34-33-101 et. seq. a Coal Exploration 180 day report is being submitted.

A total of 3 drill holes were drilled in 2018. All 3 drill holes have been abandoned, reclaimed and seeded. Each drill hole was abandoned immediately and prior to moving onto the next drill site. All three sites were re-seeded in September of 2019. All three sites were re-seeded in May of 2020.

All roads constructed to access these sites have been reclaimed and seeded.

A map has been attached to show the location of the 3 drill sites and the roads that were constructed.

Currently there are no drill rigs or test equipment on site.

There is an attachment describing the location of the 3 drill holes and which ones have been drilled, sealed, regraded, topsoiled, seeded and re-seeded.
