         Review of First Quarter 2020, Discharge Monitoring Reports**

Dear Mr. Bear:

The Division received your First Quarter 2020 Discharge Monitoring Reports (January, February, March, and the reports for the entire quarter) that resulted from your sampling of Colorado Discharge Permit System outfalls (CDPS Permit No. CO0044776). I reviewed these reports in the context of the Regulations of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board for Coal Mining, Rules 4.05.1 and 4.05.2. These rules require that the discharges from coal mines in Colorado minimize disturbance to the hydrologic balance in receiving waters below the mines, and they require that these operations adhere to State and Federal effluent limitations.

No discharges were recorded in January, February, or March. No problems were identified in the context of the cited rules.
