OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. A representative for the Operator was not present. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed.

The Van 4 Shaft is located approximately ten miles west of Naturita and accessed from Dd19 Rd. The site is a 110d operation that includes a total of 8.4 permitted acres.

At the Mined Land Reclamation Board meeting held January 22, 2020 the Board issued an Order to terminate the mining operation and ordered the Operator to commence final reclamation immediately. The Board Order was signed March 2, 2020 and mailed March 9, 2020.

This inspection verified that, to date, the Operator has failed to commence final reclamation of the site as required by the March 9, 2020 Board Order.

No other problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
