Below and attached please find documentation that I hope you find satisfactory to resolution of the problems identified on the mine.

Mine Sign - Sign has been placed at the entrance of the mine site - please see attached photo.

Markers - Survey contractor was hired to stake the boundary of the mine site, please see attached invoice from surveyor. **Fuel Storage** - The existing fuel tank has been placed in a new secondary containment container of adequate size to prevent the potential spill of fuel on to the ground. Please see attached photo.

Revegetation - Weed control was hired and implemented on the site per the approved weed control plan. This will be revisited on an annual basis and implemented as needed to control noxious weed. Please see attached receipt from The Weed Works for the work completed.
