Mr. Mittasch:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) has reviewed the completeness items you submitted for the Application for Transfer of Permit and Succession of Operators (SO-02) from Calais Resources Colorado, Inc. to Grand Island Resources, LLC.

After reviewing the materials provided, the Division has determined the following items is required for the application to be considered complete for processing:

 The Rider you provided (on July 6, 2020) is sufficient for changing the name on the existing Corporate Surety to Grand Island Resources, LLC. However, the amount of the existing Corporate Surety (\$15,400.00) does not fulfill the Financial Warranty requirement for this permit (\$31,500.00). <u>Please</u> <u>submit a Rider (with Power of Attorney) on the existing Corporate Surety for the additional \$16,100.00,</u> <u>or provide a separate form of Financial Warranty (i.e., check for deposit, corporate surety, certificate of deposit) that covers this additional amount.</u>

Your application will not be considered complete until the deficiencies identified above have been addressed. Please submit all required completeness items to our office via Certified Mail by **August 19, 2020**.
