Dear Mr. Williams:

On August 6, 2020, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Application package for the Nelson Pit, File No. M-2020-040. Preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider you application as being submitted and a technical review can begin:

Application form

1. On page 4, the no explanation was given describing the mining method. Please complete this section.
2. The form certifying that a sign was posted at the site was not signed. Please submit a signed copy of the certification.

Your 112 application will not be considered submitted/filed until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin the review. A decision date will be established 60 days from the date of receipt and acceptance of all the requested information.

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(8), you have sixty (60) days from the date of this letter to submit all necessary documents that the DRMS needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the DRMS, the DRMS may deny the application and terminate the application file. All corrected pages must also be provided to Washington County Clerk & Recorder.

The response to this Incompleteness Notice is due on or before October 11, 2020.

This letter shall not be interpreted to mean that there are no other completeness issues or technical deficiencies in your application. The DRMS will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
