New Elk Coal Company LLC, 12550 Highway 12, Weston, CD 51091, the operator of the New Elk Mine, Fermit number C-81-012, is filling a technical revision of the New Elk Mine with the State of Co(crado, Davision of Reclamation, Mining and Safety, Fermit C-51-012 renewal was approved by the Division on November 14, 2019. For filling purposes, this technical revision application was deemed complete by the Division on July 27, 2020.

The New Elk Mine is located approximately 7 miles west of Westin, Colorado in Township 33 South, Range 68 Westi, in sections 13, 14, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 27. These sections can be located on the USGS 75 minute Vigit and Waston quadrangle maps. A total of 223.80 acres of surface disturbance from mining related activity is covered by a Letter of Credit Bond and Cash Bond in the amount of 54, 166,596.08

This technical revision is to add an 'early plan' for reclamation of the RDA and specifically addresses the issue of available cover material required to complete the reclamation work in accordance with Rule 4. 10.4. The plan proposes a source for this cover material immediately adjacent to the RDA and within the previously approved disturbed area of the RDA.

The technical revision is available on the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety website for public inspection.
