Thank you for the opportunity in allowing us to respond to the Corrective Actions provided by you on June 16, 2020.

#1 INSPECTION TOPIC: Backfilling & Grading

PROBLEM: The approved Mine Plan requires the Operator to maintain a 25-foot offset from the property line and mine the perimeter at the final 3H:1V slope. The northeastern highwall previously repaired by a former Operator has eroded to within 2 feet of the permit boundary and exceeds the approved perimeter mined slope of 3H:1V.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: The Division will require the Operator to backfill the highwall to establish the required

25-foot offset from the eastern boundary and the required 3H:1V slope and provide evidence within 30 days of the mailing date of this report.

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In response to the Inspection Topic "Signs & Markers, we are respectfully requesting additional time to correct.

Reason: We have made many attempts to contact multiple survey companies and have been unsuccessful. Many of the survey companies we reached out to, did not return our phone calls and/or the companies that we were able to contact, were not able to perform the work until after the correction date. We have scheduled a survey company to perform the work on 08/14/2020 and are respectfully requesting a 30-day continuance to complete the remaining work.

#2 INSPECTION TOPIC: Signs & Markers

PROBLEM: The affected area boundary markers are missing or incorrectly placed. This is a problem for failure

to maintain boundary markers around the affected area as required by Rule 3.1.12(2).

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: The Operator shall conduct a survey and replace the boundary markers in the correct

location(s). The Operator shall provide proof to the Division that this has been done by the corrective action

date.
