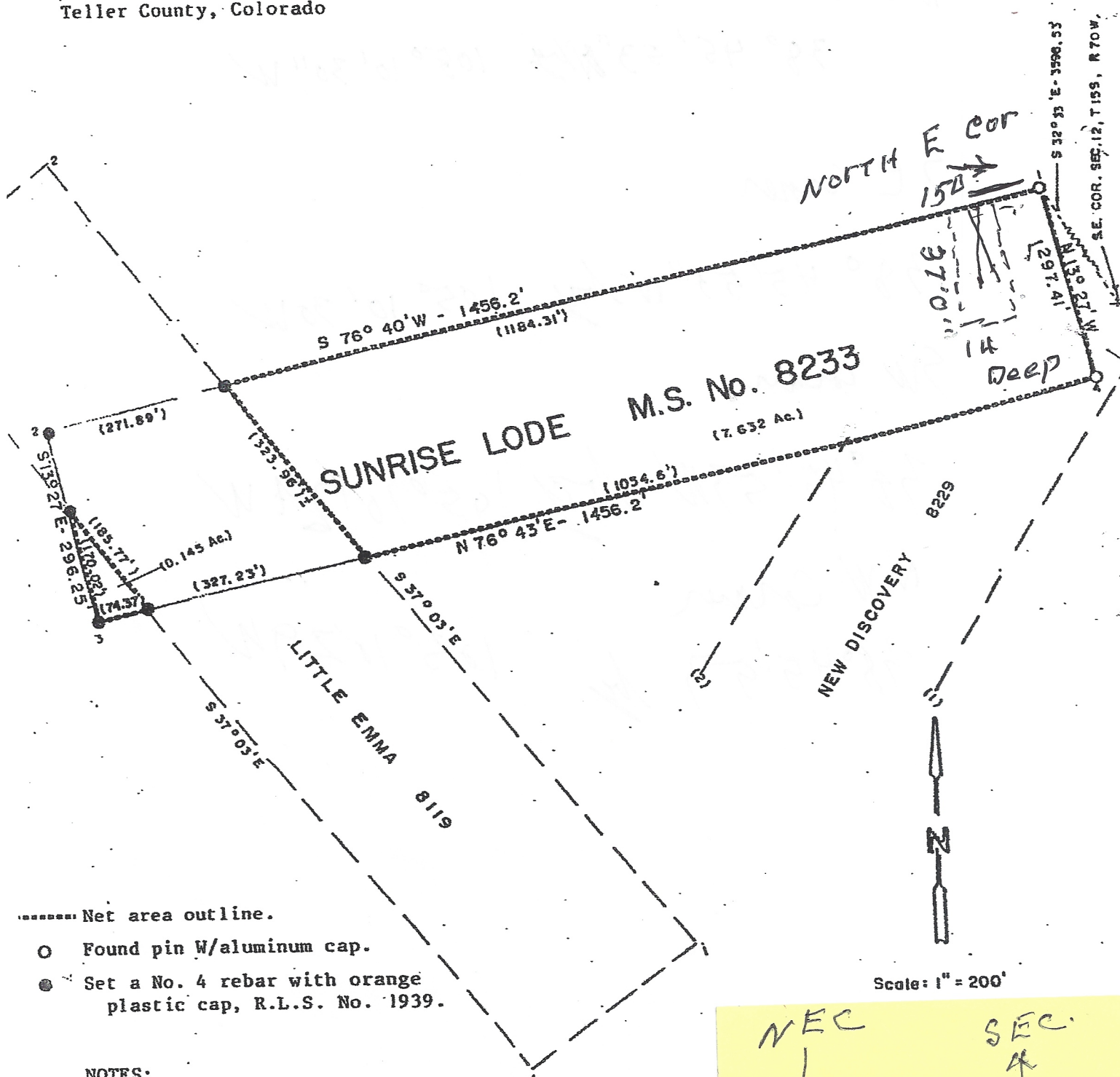






SURVEY MAP-
