If you return the land in an "As-is" condition, this will be acceptable to us. The slope doesn't seem to affect the cattle grazing. If you have any questions you are welcome to give me a call 719-472-4812. If top soil wasn't spread correctly, it would actually probably be worse for the cattle grazing ability of the ground.
