Dear Mr. Schneider:

On September 1, 2020, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Amendment application for the Humming Bird Mine 110(1) Hard Rock Reclamation Permit, which is located in Mesa County. All comment and review periods began on September 1, 2020, and a decision date has been set for October 1, 2020.

Within ten (10) days you must publish notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed mining operation. Immediately after the publication, mail a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface rights and mineral rights, holders of any recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land. Proof of notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested, must be submitted to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety prior to the decision date. Additionally, any changes or additions to the application on file in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy which has been placed with the Chaffee County Clerk and Recorder.

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Mined Land Reclamation Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed.
