On September 3, 2020, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety filed your Amendment application for the Kichelmann One 110(1) Hard Rock Reclamation Permit, which is located in Montrose County. All comment and review periods began on September 3, 2020, and a decision date has been set for October 5, 2020.

Newspaper publication of a notice (published once) regarding the filing of your amendment application and transmittal of a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface and mineral rights, holders of any recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land is required within 10 days. You must submit proof of the notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested, to the Division prior to the decision date.

The Division is reviewing your amendment application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed. Any changes or additions to the application on file in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy which has been placed with the Montrose County Clerk and Recorder.
