NOTICE INFORMATION

Your intent to twin an historic hole (GC-44) under the current Notice was received by this office on August 25, 2020. The BLM has reviewed the planned revision and determined that it is not considered a material change, and therefore does not trigger the need to file a modification for Notice COC-077472. As outlined in the surface management regulations in 43 CFR 3809.331(2), as the proposed twin hole is located within the historic access road footprint that was recently used for Hole 5 in the exploration plan associated with this Notice, no new areas will be disturbed and this will not result in an impact of a different kind, degree or extent than those already described in the Notice on file.

Amount of Financial Guarantee – The current statewide bond held by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (CDRMS) is \$107,290.00. BLM recently coordinated with CDRMS regarding the most recent bond calculation and determined that it still appears to be adequate for exploration activities associated with this Notice and planned revision. This coordination and determination concerning the financial guarantee does not relieve you, the operator, of the responsibility to comply with all applicable Federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and permit requirements. You are responsible for preventing any unnecessary or undue degradation and for reclaiming all lands disturbed by your operations.
