On September 11, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your 112c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Surety Reduction Request application for the Pikeview Quarry, located in El Paso County. Preliminary review of the information received determined that additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application complete and technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of September 14, 2020. The application was missing the following:


- *An estimate of the actual cost to reclaim the site – Rule 4.14.1(2)(b),*
- *Name, address and phone number for the US Forest Service as partial landowner.*

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1(8), you have thirty (60) days from September 14, 2020 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
