It has come to my attention that three projects are being pursued by the city of Idaho Springs, Mary Jane Lovey, and John Miner. As for the first project concerning The three is the use of tailings pile on the Gem Mine being used for either fill material or a storage lot for heavy equipment and parking. Usage of this type will disturb the tailing and release toxic materials into storm water runoff contaminating clear creek.
