Dear Mr. Briggs:

On October 1, 2020 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety **approved** the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on April 15, 2020, addressing the following:

1. *Update water monitoring program including updating stations, sampling schedule and analyte list.*
2. *Allow placement of Pilot Passive Water Treatment Materials within the monitored permit boundary*
3. *Incorporate the Waste Storage Pad and Enclosure into the list of structures.*
4. *Update the Reclamation Plan and Reclamation Plan Map to address minor modifications including topsoil placement and vegetation plans to incorporate the Waste Storage Pad and Enclosure.*

The terms of the Technical Revision No. 11 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-2012-032. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-2012-032 remain in full force and effect. Please note that on Page 3, response item 3, it was stated that several corrected versions of drawings that are currently in the Permit File will be submitted under a separate cover. Please submit those drawing as soon as you are able, as an Addendum to TR-11. Also, as a result of this revision a Reclamation Cost Estimate has been performed. Division staff found that the currently held Financial Warranty is **sufficient** to achieve reclamation of the site including the changes associated with TR-11.
