Mr. Caskey:

On September 27, 2020 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your application for a Construction Materials Limited Impact Operation (110c) Reclamation Permit. A preliminary review of the information received determined that the following items must be received before the Division can consider the application submitted and technical review can begin:

1. Pursuant to the requirements of Rule 6.3.5, provide Exhibit E Mining Plan Map and Reclamation Plan Map.
2. Pursuant to the requirements of Rule 6.3.6, provide Exhibit F List of Other Permits and Licenses Required.
3. Pursuant to the requirements of Rule 6.3.7, provide Exhibit G Source of Legal Right-to-Enter.
4. Pursuant to the requirements of Rule 6.3.9, provide Exhibit I Proof of Filing with County Clerk.

Your application will not be considered filed until the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review. A decision date will be established 30 days from the date of receipt of all of the requested information.

Pursuant to Rule 1.4.1 (8), you have sixty days from the date of this letter to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in the application. The Division will review your application in order to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the *Colorado Land Reclamation Act for the Extraction of Construction Materials* after submittal of all required items.
