I am specifically aggrieved by this proposed project for the following reasons:


Possibility of damage to our wells. Our wells in this neighborhood are minimal at best and this type of mining operation will possibly further degrade our existing wells.

Increased truck traffic on highway 9. An increase of 225 truck trips a day is unacceptable. That stretch of highway 9 is dangerous enough without adding this type of increase in traffic.

Commercial operation in a low density residential zoning. The property is not zoned for this type of use and is contrary to the County Master Plan.
