Martin Marietta received a copy of the 2017 Minerals Program Inspection Report for our Sokol Pit, Permit Number M-1980-193. A problem/possible violation was noted related to the NextEra transmission powerline that runs along the south side of the property. The problem relates to the powerline being within 200 feet of the permitted mining area, thus requiring us to enter into a Structures Agreement with NextEra, or otherwise demonstrate that our activities will not damage the transmission powerline. Appended is a copy of a Structures Agreement Letter from NextEra that should resolve this issue.
