RE: Cresson Project; M1980-244, Third Quarter 2020 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Report – Review Memo

On October 21, 2020, the Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety received via email the Third Quarter 2020 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Report. I reviewed the report for consistency to ensure that all constituents were being reported accurately. Below is a summary of my review.

- A standard exceedance for beryllium in SGMW-6B was not reported. During review of the 2nd Quarter 2020 report a similar exceedance in the same well was also missed and was brought to the attention of the operator.
- 2. A standard exceedance for sulfate in CRMW-3B was not reported.
- 3. During review it was noted the fluoride concentration in GVMW-8A is equal to the NPL/TVS value of 2 mg/L and was not reported or commented on.

This concludes my review of the Third Quarter 2020 Groundwater and Surface Water Monitoring Report.
