Dear Ms. Harmon:

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS) received a request for a Technical Revision (TR-124) addressing the following:

Carlton Tunnel Mapping Adjustment

The submittal was called complete for the purpose of filing on October 6, 2020. The **decision date for TR-124 is November 5, 2020**. Please be advised that if you are unable to satisfactorily address any concerns identified in this review before the decision date, **it will be your responsibility to request an extension of the review period**. If there are outstanding issues that have not been adequately addressed prior to the end of the review period, and no extension has been requested, the Division may deny this Technical Revision.

The following comment is based on the DRMS review of the request for TR-124:

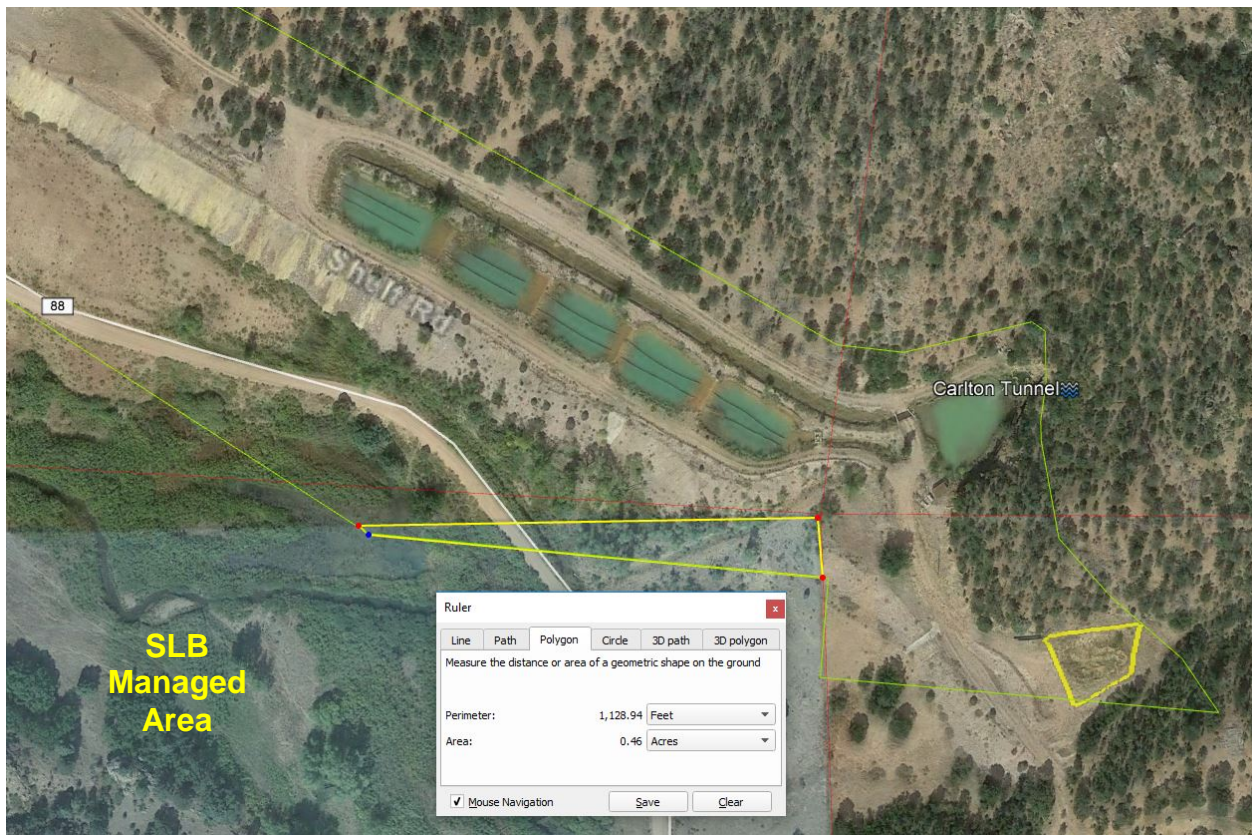


Figure 1. SLB Overlap Area

- 1) Legal Right of Entry: There is an area of nearly 0.5 acres on the proposed boundary clarification map that overlaps land managed by the State Land Board (SLB), see Figure 1. The inclusion of this area would require documentation authorizing legal right of entry from the SLB. If this was the original intent, such documentation should already exist. Please either provide legal right of entry or recheck your records to eliminate this overlap from the boundary clarification map.
