Mr. Phillips:

Please be advised, on November 12, 2020, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) approved Grand Island Resources LLC's request for release of a portion of the Cross Gold Mine permit area from further reclamation responsibility (see enclosed AR-01 approval letter).

In accordance with Rule 1.4.11, if you wish to appeal the Division's decision on AR-01, you must petition for a hearing before the Mined Land Reclamation Board (Board) within thirty (30) days of the date of the Division's decision (by December 12, 2020). Such a petition for a hearing must state how you are directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by the Division's decision, and how your interests are entitled to protection under the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act. The petition must list and explain any issues you believe should be considered by the Board at the hearing on the matter. The petition must also specifically state the application or file number assigned by the Division (in this case, Permit No. M-1977-410, Acreage Reduction No. 1 or AR-01).
